IV. Agenda Item: AB 705: Next Steps.

DISCUSSION: The AP&P committee reviewed the effects of implementing AB 705 on pre-transfer level MATH requisites.

- Currently, the MATH department plans on no longer offering pre-transfer level courses. This impacts courses that have pre-transfer level MATH requisites.
- For MATH advisories, the discipline faculty reevaluates the need for the MATH advisory and has the option
 to (1) remove the advisory and integrate specific math concepts in the course or (2) use the language
 "math pre-transfer level or equivalent or higher or placement based on college processes".
- For MATH pre-transfer level prerequisites and corequisites, there is a need for more robust discussion and collaboration to determine the MATH pre/corequisite requirements for transfer to CSU or UC. Consider keeping the prerequisite if truly needed for transfer and add "equivalent or higher or placement based on college processes."
- The AP&P committee will continue to review the pre-transfer level MATH and ENGL requisites in the course proposals.

- Noncredit proposals stalled in the review process new positions are proposed in the workflow that will keep noncredit proposals moving forward automatically.

- Who should review new noncredit courses? Modified courses?
- How should students find noncredit courses in the catalog? Do the noncredit courses follow the related credit courses? Should the noncredit courses be listed in a separate section in the catalog?


