	Justification: CTE. The proposal is in response to labor market demand, advisory committee recommendation, and need to create a formal Family and Consumer Sciences pathway for students. The certificate organizes existing courses that supports entry-level employment preparation in community and human services, youth and family support, and related fields. It also addresses a gap in the current curriculum by allowing students to earn a certificate in an area that currently does not exist as a stand-alone program at the college. LMI: It meets these criteria: supply gap and education. It does not meet self-sufficiency standard living wage. The program was recommended.

Role of AP&P Committee regarding Credit for Prior Learning.

- A full course approval process is not necessary because CPL does not require COCI submission. It also slows the CPL by at least a full curriculum development cycle.
- Roles and Processes Proposal:
 - CurriQunet will be a repository of CPL information.
 - The discipline faculty and the department will review and approve course and program eligibility for CPL. The department will update APPC on the specific CPL.
 - A faculty-led CPL team will process the student request for CPL. In the event a new student request for CPL consideration arises, the CPL team will contact respective discipline faculty, program coordinator, and/or department chair.
 - The discipline faculty, program coordinator, and/or department chair will decide on the student request and will inform APPC for record keeping.
- Creating a Noncredit course CPL Pathway.
 - This applies to mirrored courses.
 - Since UC recognizes Credit by Exam, the discipline faculty and department can consider the final exam as the mechanism for CBE for these noncredit mirrored courses.
- CurriQunet Fields Proposals.
 - Keep current CBE and create a new field: Credit for Prior Learning.
 - Remove CBE and create a new field: Credit for Prior Learning with multiple options that include:
 - ☐ Credit by Exam
 - ☐ Industry Certification
 - ☐ Portfolio
