In the event that someone should know how our new process works, here is my best articulation of it.

Coordinator is put into the AP&P workflow as the required step prior to items moving on to the AP&P committee (this will change January 1, 2024) for modified courses and programs. The LRC dean is the required step for new courses and programs. Librarian in charge of the library review looks to see why a course or program is being modified (or proposed), and then looks to see if the library has: a) the adopted texts as identified in the COR, and b) sufficient supplemental materials should students need additional resources for the course (usually new courses and programs have a need to get more support materials. See above for examples of how memos would read.

New courses and program memos get emailed to the LRC Dean, so they can approve the step and move the proposal along. Modified courses and programs get added to a running memo the Librarian keeps that will be added to the curriculum summary reports as AP&P produces them. New courses and programs go on the running memo as well, but with a see new memo notation.

After the memo has been written, write the findings in Curricunet to record the result: either "Library has sufficient resources to support this course/program." or "Library does not have a copy of the adopted text/Library does not have sufficient supplemental resources to support this course/program. Cost to acquire materials is roughly \$XXX.XX."

That is the most of the function. Librarian is an ex oficio position on the committee, and has a space to report at the end of meetings if so desired. The only other requirement is to deliver the library memo to the committee prior to a curriculum summary report moving on.
