

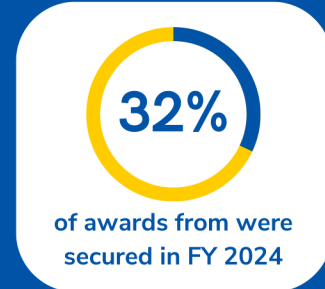

Grant Highlights in Fiscal Year 2024



\$2,640,000

HireUP - a pilot financial aid program, established to provide stipends for formerly incarcerated or foster youth to help with financial barriers to college. Each participant has a monthly disbursement based on their course load each semester and monitored for academic standing.



\$1,783,224

CollegeCorps - placement of 54 student fellows to provide meaningful service opportunities and workforce development while supporting the work of local nonprofits to address K-12 education, food insecurity, or climate action needs.



\$1,545,454

Rising Scholars Juvenile Justice - provide programming within court or juvenile hall facilities, support transition to college, and provide wrap around services to support student success through collaborative partnership with county agencies.



\$1,500,000

Padilla Congressional Appropriations for Nursing - funding to build a 6,500 square foot facility which will house a skills lab shared by LVNs and RNs, lecture hall, computer lab, student lockers, conference room, student breakroom, and offices for faculty.



\$500,000

CERF Uplift / REACH - partners leverage organizational and professional resources to boost training and create pathways into living wage employment gaps throughout the region in agriculture, hospitality, manufacturing, healthcare, information services and finance.
