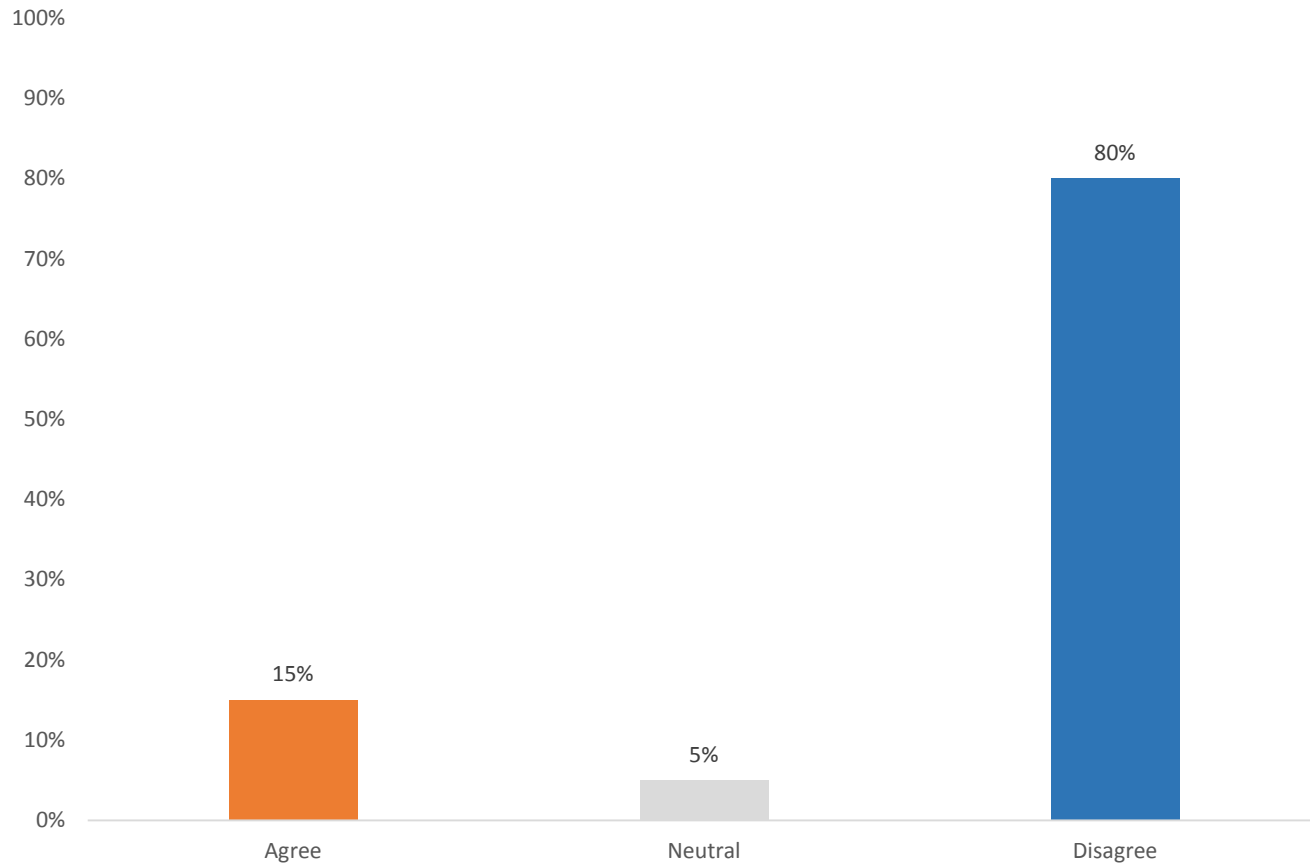
Breakdown by Smokers, Neutrals, and Non-Smokers

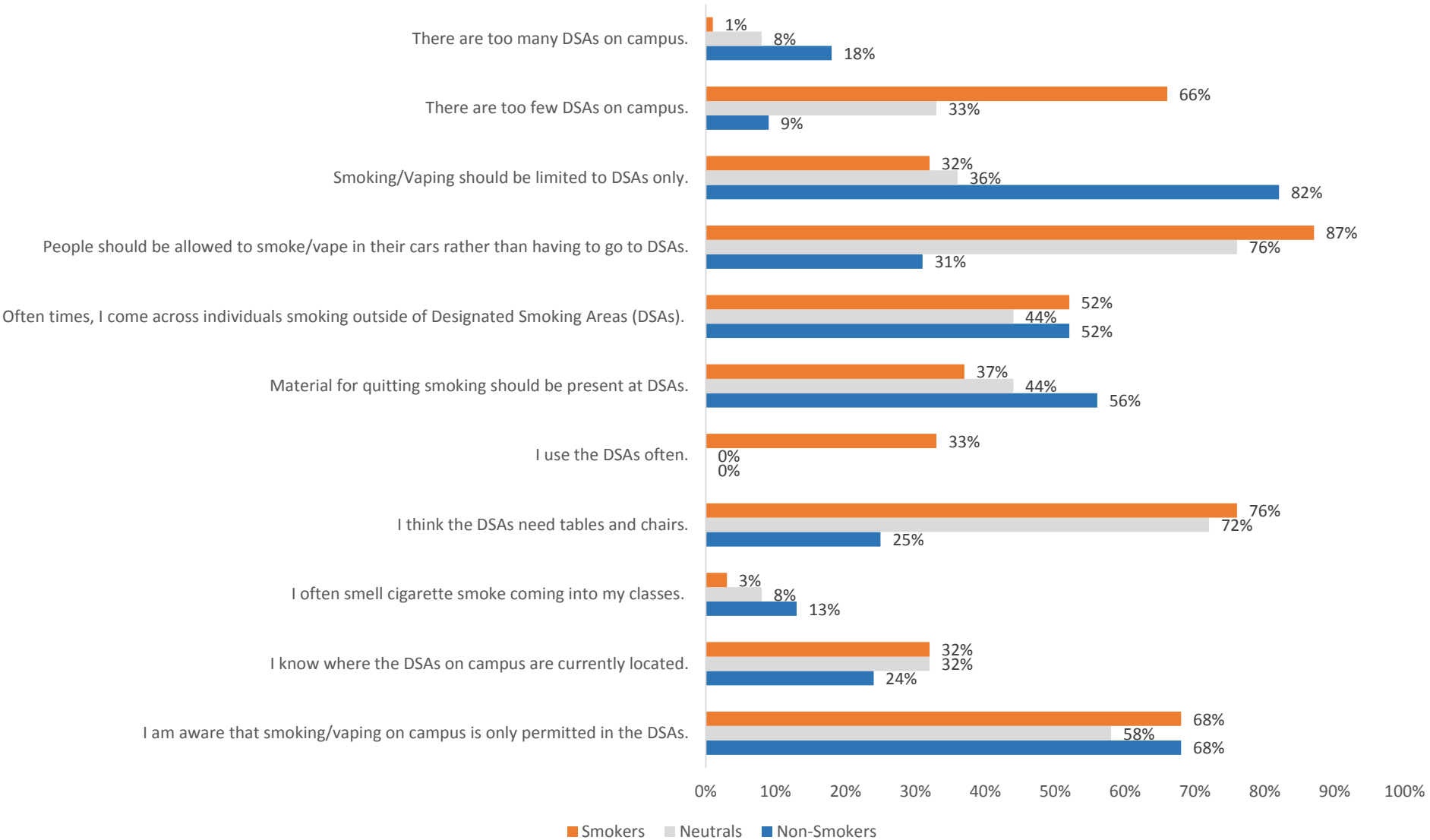
ASBG Smoking Survey

- There was a total of 572 surveys opened.
- 515 students completed the survey.
- Of those 515 students, 411 were non-smokers (80%), 25 were neutral (5%), and 79 were smokers (15%)
