

### Light Job Posting Demand Over an Average Supply of Regional Jobs









### Most Jobs are Found in the Education and Hospitals (Local Government) Industry Sector






# Compensation











### **Racial Diversity**





## Occupation Race/Ethnicity Breakdown




## **Occupation Gender Breakdown**
