Light Job Posting Demand Over a Thin Supply of Regional Jobs




Jobs (2023)











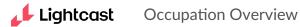


Top Distinguishing Skills by Demand







Retirement risk is about average in your area. The national average for an area this size is 117* employees 55 or older, while there are 123 here.


Racial Diversity


Gender Diversity

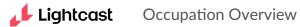


Occupation Race/Ethnicity Breakdown


