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NEW AHC DATA DASHBOARDS

Spring 2023 has been a busy time for data dashboards at AHC.

Below are some of the highlights:

- The old static PDF document showing high school going rates from the top AHC feeder high schools has been reimaged to an interactive data dashboard that now allows for cohort tracking and simple demographics.
- The Factbook has been retired and replaced by an elegant, yet powerful, dashboard that answers almost all headcount questions about AHC students.
- Program data has been completely overhauled to three focused dashboards that answer a multitude of questions programs can have about their students and about AHC overall. Very handy for program review purposes but also useful for general program data.

HIGH SCHOOL GOING RATES

The high school going rates dashboard can be accessed via the [IE data page](#) under the 'High School Data' section.

There are two main sections for the dashboard as shown in the image below.

1) The year directly after graduating high school

HS GOING RATE

OR

2) Cumulative over multiple years after graduating high school

COHORT TRACKER

- The 'HS Going Rate' button displays data similar to the old static PDF previously posted on the IE website.

HS Going Rate - Recent* high school grads

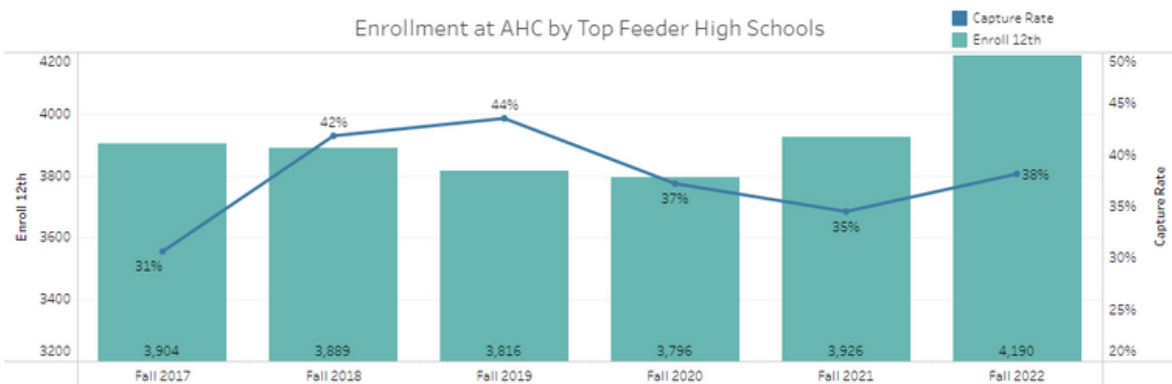

Enrollment at AHC by Top Feeder High Schools



All headcount is census based

This data sheet shows basic high school going rate information for the top feeder high schools. Every fall term shows the 12th grade high school enrollment for the prior academic year, the number of those students who enrolled at AHC, and the capture rate. The graph shows the same data with the bars as overall 12th grade enrollments (from the feeder high schools) and the line as AHC capture rate.

HIGH SCHOOL COHORT TRACKER

The cohort tracker looks at the high school students enrolled in a chosen year (Cohort) and how many of these students enrolled at AHC over multiple years (Capture Rate). For all feeder high schools most of the AHC enrollment is the subsequent year from the cohort year.

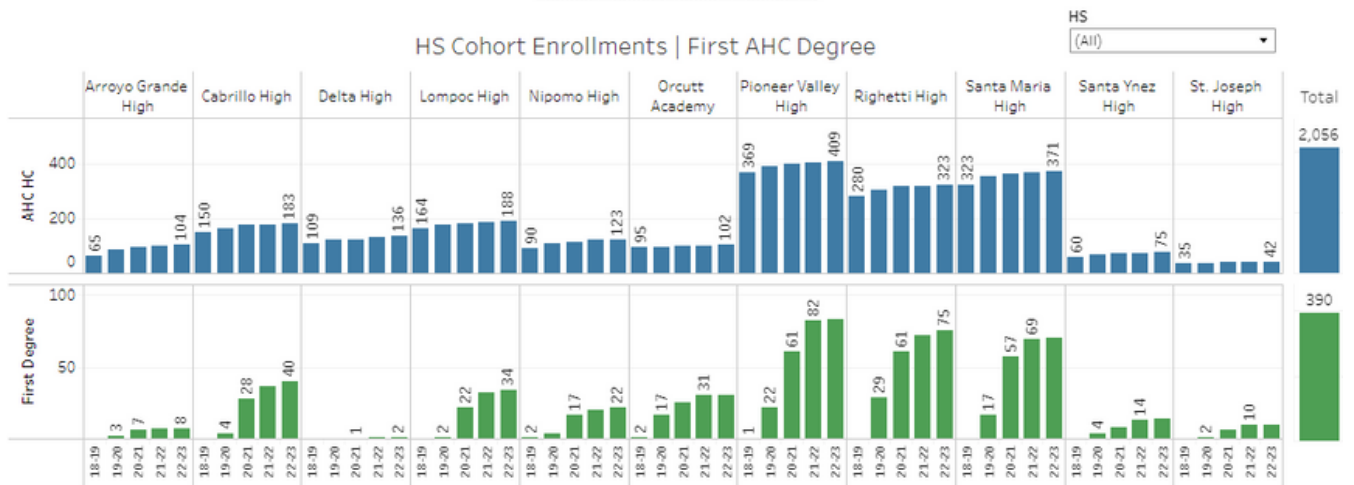
HS Grad Year Cohort Tracker

The graphs at the bottom show the same headcount data from the table in blue and degree acquisition in green. Because we know students at AHC earn multiple degrees the data in green is only the FIRST degree earned at AHC. The degree data shows most students from these high school cohorts earned their first degree in year three or four.

But that's not all! All cohort tracker data can be filtered by basic student groups: Gender (Male or Female) or Simple Ethnicity (Hispanic or White). Use the filter in the top right corner.

And if you have any questions about the dashboard click on the lightbulb icon  to get an informative walk-through of the various data on the dashboard.

HEADCOUNT & EMPLOYEE DATA

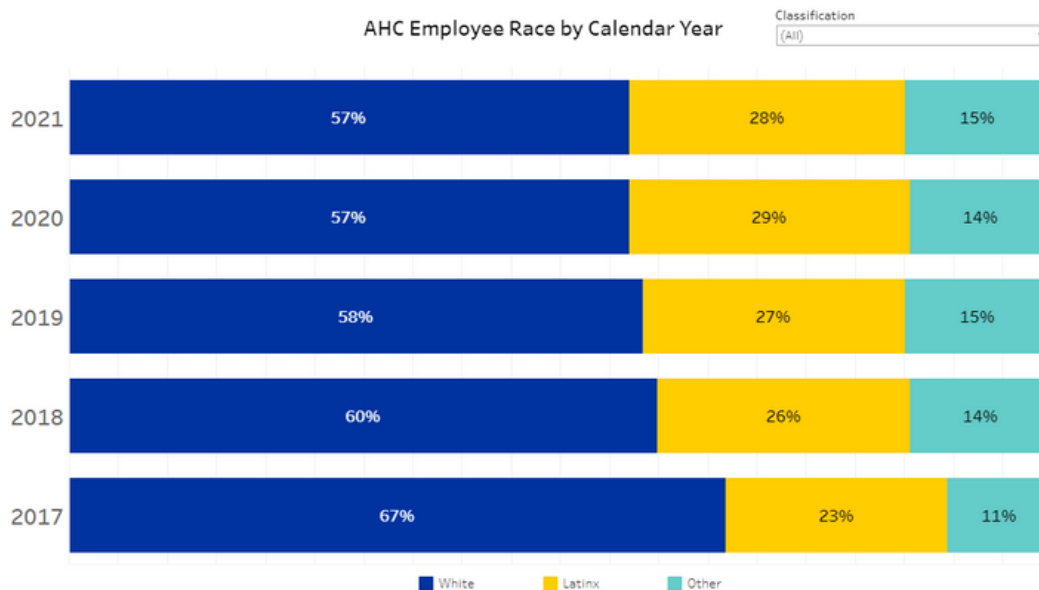
The headcount data dashboard and the employee dashboard can be accessed via the [IE data page](#) under the 'Quick Data' section.

With the retirement of the Interactive Factbook the IE office is happy to introduce a simpler and more efficient way to get headcount data for AHC students. With the ability to see data sorted by 26 different filter options, and be able to use two filters at the same time, there is data suited for anybody.

HEADCOUNT DATA



The above example shows headcount data by gender and HS GPA over the last four completed academic years. Green trendlines quickly show if the row is increasing or decreasing over time. And, similar to the high school going rate dashboard a user can click on the light bulb icon to get an informative walk-through of how to use the dashboard.



The employee demographics dashboard shows percentages (as seen in the image above) and counts across the previous five calendar years. Data can be sorted by ethnicity, gender, age, and employee classification.

The data source for employee data is the CCCCO MIS data.

PROGRAM DATA

Three new program dashboards (Awards & Transfer, Enrollment & Headcount, and Success & Retention) can be accessed via the [IE data page](#) under the 'College & Program Data' section.



All three of the updated program data dashboards utilize a button based navigation system. As seen in the image to the left, the intro page has large descriptive buttons helping the user navigate to the appropriate data along with simple data definitions at the bottom.

Data Definitions:

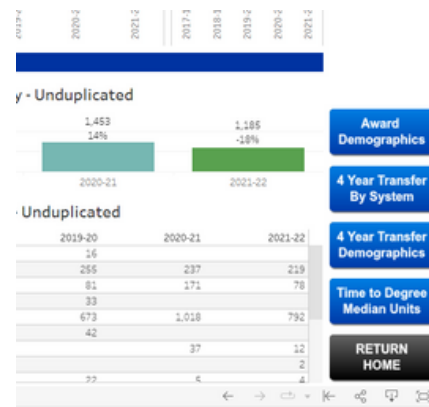
Unduplicated: The count of how many individual students received an award. If a student receives multiple awards they are only counted a single time.

Duplicated: The count of how many total awards were received.

Primary Term: The first fall or spring term a student enrolled at AHC.

Time to First Degree (TTD): The median amount of time it takes a student to earn their FIRST degree at AHC measured in years.

Every data sheet has navigation buttons in the bottom right (as seen in the image to the right) allowing users to see other data in the dashboard or return home.

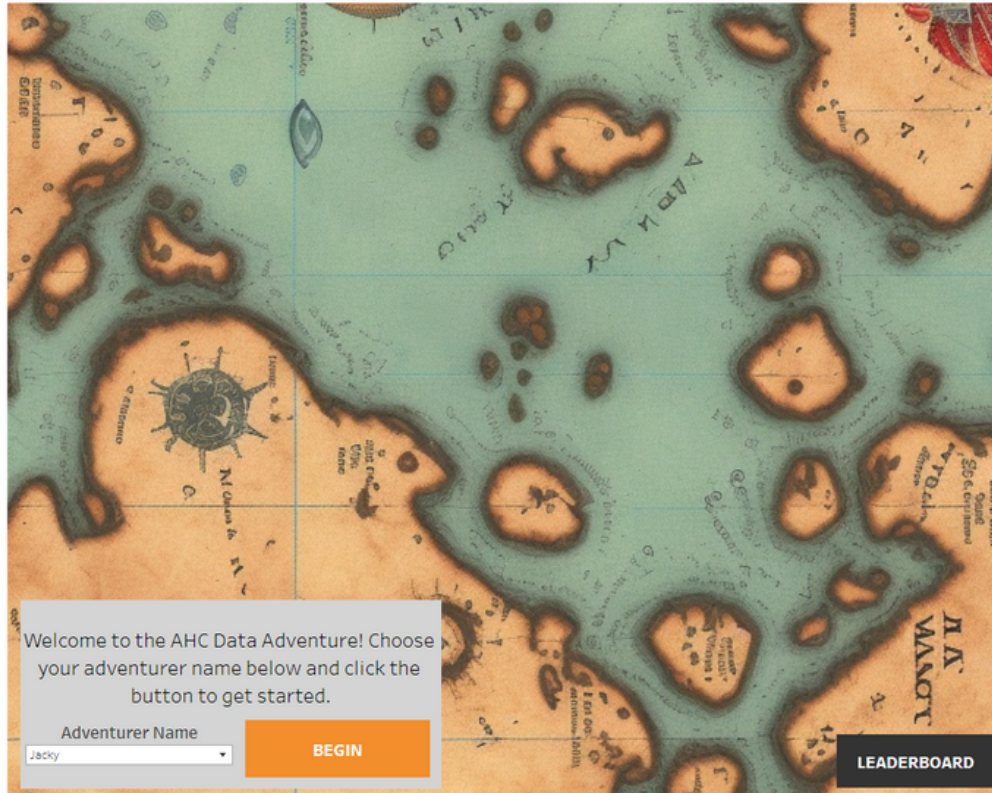

QUICK BITES

In spring 2023 about 28% (2871) of AHC headcount (unduplicated) is comprised of special admit students (college now or concurrent). This is a 13 percentage point increase over spring 2019 when only about 15% (1563) of AHC headcount was comprised of special admit students.
