This AP has minor changes with language to implement student holds for registration if they don't have a Comprehensive Student Education Plan (CSEP.) This is based on Assembly Bill 928. This AP has league language to help clarify definitions and changes to the organizational structure of the document. Faculty inquired about the definition of "Day" to identify them as procedural days – not class days. And asked if the definitions apply only to procedural processes. 17. Grants Report. [5] (L. McNulty)

L. McNulty shared the grants report. Any items in yellow involve faculty and curriculum. Several regional grants were shared that support workforce programs, that support CTE students, workplace learning, and internships. Another OER/ZTC grant is in the process. The Rising Scholars grants support OER and ZTC for our partner institutions. Several grants are being explored to expand the nursing program and facilities, as well as a BSRN program. The current administration policies are affecting several grants in process and popular annual grants. See the Senate SharePoint for details or contact L. McNulty with questions.

18. 2025 CCCCIO Conference Report [5] (B. Curry)

A report on the theme and topics discussed at the recent California Community Colleges Chief Instructional Officers Conference.

R. Curry shared some slides from a statewide AI Survey. They are available on the CCCCIO website. He also

shared they are switching to a new form of attendance accounting that affects lecture and lab hours in courses. He will expand on this at a later date. Credit for Prior Learning, Financial Aid Fraud, and Dual Enrollment were other topics discussed.

19. ASCCC 2025 Spring Plenary Resolutions and Sessions Update. [10] (AR/FP/D. Degroot)

Updates to the agenda are linked to the agenda. Please look at the ones that are up for discussion on Friday and voted for on Saturday. Restrepo shared frustration with the process of getting local Ethnic Studies courses articulating consistently with CSUs. D. Degroot has a proposal that addresses this issue that will be discussed and voted on this weekend. Please review and email Restrepo with questions or concerns on any item.

20. Budget Committee. (G. Bierly/D. Curran)

D. Curran spoke to the Senate and shared that the budget report looks better than originally projected. The committee will know more in mid-May with the governor's revised budget. He advised faculty to submit Budget Augmentations as needed and reach out to R. Curry if program budgets need a Restricted Lottery increase in funding.
