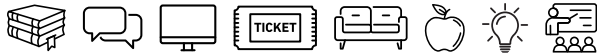


*CAN-TRIO (Achievement Now)

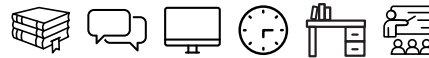

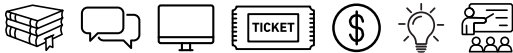
