REFER TO COURSE CRITERIA

Students interested in applying to the Cal Poly Business Administration Bachelor's Pathway at Hancock Program should refer to Cal Poly's transfer course criteria for business.

If you have questions about whether your courses meet the transfer course criteria, please meet with an advisor at your community college transfer center.

Apply for the Cal Poly Bachelor's Pathway at Hancock Program Fall 2026: B.S. Business Administration, Management and Human Resources concentration.

Select "Business @ Allan Hancock College" as your major when applying to Cal Poly through Cal State Apply.

FINANCIAL AID: Be sure to include the appropriate school code on your financial aid application for Cal Poly (school code 001143) who will be administering your aid for this program.

CONSIDER THE FIT

Course Availability	Curriculum will be offered only in Fall and Spring Terms at the Allan Hancock College campus taught by Cal Poly Faculty. Specific course offerings and flowcharts coming soon.
Unit Load	Students will take 14 units in Fall and 14 units in Spring during their first year. In the second year (final year), students will take 17 units in Fall and 15 units in Spring.
Course Schedule	Courses will be offered in the evenings, as they are intentionally designed to support the needs of working students and student-parents. Classes will run Monday through Thursday from 5–7:40 p.m., with one early course per week (typically on Mondays) from 4–5 p.m.
Degree Requirements	Students will follow the Cal Poly semester catalog for Business Administration with a concentration in MHR.
Additional Coursework	Students with fewer than 60 units, or those missing lower-division requirements, may need to complete additional coursework to qualify. It is strongly recommended that you meet with an AHC transfer counselor to confirm all requirements are met prior to applying to

this program.
